# FOR THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY:

(Gospel: John 16: 12-15)

The Gospel is taken from the Last Supper discourse. In this brief text, we are presented with Jesus, as ever, trying to care for his disciples with careful explanations. Shortly before this reading begins (in verse 7), he has said, "I tell you the truth...." But Jesus realizes they are not ready for all the truth, so he holds back with certain things, like his impending Passion and Death. What they can "bear" he shares forcefully and that truth concerns the coming of the "Spirit of truth" who will make clear all that they have learned from Jesus.

In the verses immediately preceding this text, Jesus has shared something very counterintuitive: "It is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you." The Spirit will come, not to bring new revelations, but to help them understand what they've already heard or experienced.

While other sections of the farewell discourse may feel more intimate, there is no lack of care in this passage. Jesus knows the events of the next few days will be disorienting for the disciples, so he prepares them to hold on to their faith and to await the One who will vindicate both Jesus and their confidence in him. Jesus' self-confidence and the assurance he offers his disciples remain efficacious for each of us today who hears these words. The Spirit continues to witness to the "truth", who is Christ, God's living Word.


