For the 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time (2nd Reading):

Just as we turn to busy people when we need something done, it would seem we should turn to those in greatest need when we need our faith bolstered. Paul proves that irony by telling the Philippians to “not worry about anything” while he himself faces the possibility of imminent death. His deep faith, fostered over many years and through many trials, has convinced him that God is an ally we can trust in all situations, someone we approach not with desperation but “with thanksgiving.” That within his jail cell he could well up with peace and gratefulness proves to Paul that a power that “surpasses all understanding” stood guard over his heart and mind.

Paul expects the parousia – Christ’s return in glory – at any time; and if Jesus doesn’t come soon, surely his own death will. These twin convictions inspire his instructions to be wholly focussed on what is “true,” “honourable,” “just,” “pure,” “pleasing,” and “commendable.” Spending time with mindless pursuits is not worthy of us. Our hearts and minds should focus only on those things that beat in rhythm with the heart of God.




