CONFIRMATION CLASSES: For those in grade 7 and up who would like to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation here at St. Louis parish, classes will begin on September 16 at 7pm in the convent. The sessions will run once a week until Sunday, November 22nd, when all will be confirmed. **Please register ahead of time with Kelly Krause at the parish office.**

Good Shepherd Catechesis Program (CGS) –is a program for children ages 3 through 12. It is based on the teaching methods of Maria Montessori. In this program, an environment is prepared, called the atrium. It is a place where Christ may be encountered in Word and Action; where the spiritual life of the child is nurtured. The work of the child becomes prayer and conversation with God. It is a place where children grow in the knowledge of Jesus and His love. The hands-on materials in the atrium encourage children to explore and deepen their experiences at their own pace. Classes will run on Mondays, beginning September 21 from 3:45-5:30pm for both Level I – ages 3-6yrs old, and Level II/III – ages 7-12yrs old. Laudato Si is Pope Francis' encyclical on the

environment with a secondary title of – On Care for Our Common Home. Laudato Si means "Praise be to you" which is the first line of a canticle by St. Francis that praises God with all of his creation.

From the outset, Pope Francis states the goal of the document: "In this Encyclical, I would like to enter into dialogue with all people about our common home" (#3). Normally, papal documents are addressed to the bishops of the Church or the lay faithful. But, similar to Pope Saint John XXIII's Pacem in Terris, Pope Francis addresses his message to all people.

The goal of the dialogue: "I urgently appeal, then, for a new dialogue about how we are shaping the future of our planet. We need a conversation that includes everyone, since the environment challenge we are undergoing, and its human roots, concern and affect us all" (#14). This is at the heart of the document, but Pope Francis also has a call to conversion for those in the Church too.

"The ecological crisis is also a summons to profound interior conversion. It must be said that some committed and prayerful Christians, with the excuse of realism and pragmatism, tend to ridicule expressions of concern for the environment. Others are passive; they

choose not to change their habits and thus become inconsistent. So what they all need is an 'ecological conversion', whereby the effects of their encounter with Jesus Christ become evident in their relationship with the world around them. Living our vocation to be protectors of God's handiwork is essential to a life of virtue; it is not an optional or a secondary aspect of our Christian experience" (#217).
