Peace Be With You!

Last week, on Good Friday, Jesus' last human breath was expelled from His body and today, Jesus, risen from the dead, breathes upon His apostles and announces peace – the peace of the New Creation in His Name.

This makes for a great coming together of grace this weekend. We are celebrating the Octave of Easter, which is also called, Divine Mercy Sunday. This title draws on the devotion to the saving and merciful love of Jesus that formed the heart of St. Faustina Kowalska's lifelong prayer. Jesus breathes His Holy Spirit on the apostles and on Monday, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Annunciation.

In response to the Holy Father's request in 2023, Archbishop Leo has provided all our parishes with resources to help us to be consecrated to Mary on or near the Solemnity of the Annunciation. At the end of each Mass this weekend, some of these prayers will be used to give each and every one of us the opportunity to draw close to Mary in this way.

You may be asking why the Annunciation is being celebrated so late this year. Well, when Easter's date causes the feast to fall within Holy Week or the Octave of Easter, the celebration is moved to the next available date. This year that date is April 8th! Next year the Annunciation will be on March 25th as we normally expect it to be.

This year we have a wonderful coming together of Christ, the Holy Spirit, and the loving Mother of Christ and the Church. There are many intentions that we have in our lives, but I would ask you to add prayers for the whole Church. Despite all the stresses and questions in the present day, when we

stop and let go of our own attachments, and welcome the Lord Jesus at the Eucharistic banquet, we express our hope and what is already true. Together, we are a communion united by the Lord, Himself. None of us can claim to have a perfect understanding of our faith and all of us have to admit our own weakness and limitation in living it every day. Despite these things, the Lord, who has come for the sick, forms us, calls us His friends and makes us one with Him. It is that overwhelming grace that gives us hope and allows us to entrust ourselves to His merciful love. May Mary, our Mother, lead us into all faith that we may be one holy people in mercy and in truth.


