### Living Out Our Faith: The Fruits of Alpha

Last weekend was the final session of our parish's Alpha program, which has been running after the 11am Mass for the last twelve weeks. This weekend I will be meeting with the group of people who participated in the weekly seminars.

Even before that conversation I can share with you some of the outcomes that already are evident:

 You may have heard about our "Little Saints" group. They are going to be doing some singing at our coffee social after the 11am Mass next week. It looks like this group will support our movement toward having a children's choir that sings periodically at the 11am Mass. This group will also provide deeper connection to St. Paul's School and families there. The older children have already been displaying some leadership capacity too which is a good sign for the further development of youth ministry and activities at the parish.

- 2. I will be listening to creative ideas and suggestions to help enliven the parish and enrich our faith lives. The Holy Spirit is sometimes like a gentle breath and sometimes there is also fire, some animation and engagement that reveals the active love of God. I should be able to report very soon on a few ideas that will lead to our next steps.
- 3. I've sensed a desire for involvement and a deep sense of commitment among people in the group. This will help us to strengthen existing ministries and give us the possibility to develop new ones.

More remotely, but also important, is that it is this type of engagement that will lead us to develop a parish pastoral council. The vision here is for a group of parishioners whose strengths are discerning and facilitating further growth of the parish's life. This is not a planning committee or an executive committee. It is a group of people who know and understand the breadth of the parish community, and who are aware of some of the gifts and talents within the community. The group can help to lay down seeds and nurture them so that the result is a community that naturally helps and supports everyone's faith and life. More will be forthcoming. Please pray that we grow well together.

This is an important Advent for us as we see the work of the Spirit bear fruit.
