The Family of Faith Campaign St. Paul's Basilica is launching its



Family of Faith Campaign. The campaign has already taken place in about half the parishes of the diocese. For every dollar raised, one quarter will remain in the parish. The rest will be used to develop more effective youth ministry, chaplaincy in post-secondary institutions, develop a fund for the renovation of old churches and another fund to build new churches. Funds will also be used to continue the renovation of the cathedral and enhance ministerial skills.

The goal set for St. Paul's in the five year campaign is \$295,000. If we exceed that goal then 75% of fund collected will stay in the parish. You will be approached to make a pledge to support the effort over the next five years. We have worked at this quietly to this point and in fact have pledges totalling \$76,000 or 25% of our goal to date. The funds in the parish have two purposes. One is to hire a full time lay staff to work in the parish. Sr. Nida can only be available on weekends. We also need to develop a fund to cover the costs of maintaining our historic building. We do that through our preservation fund, but we need to recognize the expenses in maintaining the basilica are now more and more the responsibility of the Parish. You will hear much more about the Family of Faith campaign as we move forward. We will ask for your good support and prayers as this work is undertaken.
