

2nd Sunday of Lent

Lulled by the repetition of my days, I often miss what matters most. Moments pass me like newsfeeds as I blindly scroll...scroll... scroll from one duty to the next. No wonder I grow jaded. Or rather: No *wonder*, I grow jaded.

Without even realizing – or perhaps because of it - I have grown bored, weary and indifferent. A sure sign it's time to take a hike.

Come on, Jesus says, tapping our shoulders, drawing us away to be alone with him on a mountaintop. Answer that invitation to rise above it all; to be still and breathe deep; to see Jesus with new eyes.
