



A Message from the Pastor



The One Gift that Brings Life

People were as questioning in Jesus' own time as we are today. Often, He was indirect when He responded. A big theme that comes up again and again is the Kingdom of Heaven. Jesus chooses to give us all kinds of comparisons: "The Kingdom of Heaven is like..."

the Donate button. Check that "St. Paul's Basilica, Toronto" is selected from the Parish drop down menu when signing up.




Welcome to Our Neophytes and Newly Received
