The Penitential Rite

With the new translation of the liturgy there seems to be greater limits put on the penitential rite at mass. The translation of the first rite is such that it infers that those in the congregation have greatly sinned which would be fine to use if it was true. Most of us do not sin grievously from week to week and children never.

We tend to use the third rite at all masses because it does not involve any prompts, the congregation just responds with Lord have mercy, etc.

We could use the second rite but it requires that the congregation either remember the two responses or be open to page 6 at the bottom half of the page ready to give the responses. Let's make it a Lenten objective to work towards remembering these responses.

Priest: Have Mercy on us, O Lord People: For we have sinned against you. Priest: Show us, O Lord, your mercy. People: And Grant us Your Salvation
