34th Week in Ordinary Time

When celebrating the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, it should not be our version of a playground brag – "Oh yeah? Well, my Jesus is the King of the Universe!" Today's Gospel reminds us that there is no such structure in this world for anyone to reign over. Much of the sacred scripture was written during persecution, so we could expect occasional claims that Jesus ruled over the persecutors. But political power is also not the point. Somehow in the depths of the universe there is a divine structure. Jesus is king because the universe is in harmony with his life, teaching and sacrifice. In St. Peter's Square, the central obelisk, which is topped by a cross, is surrounded by eight stones, each depicting a wind from a different direction. Beyond that, moving out from the cross of Christ, is a line along which are depicted constellations, the signs of the Zodiac. This functions as a solar calendar but, more importantly, it reminds us that the cross is the center of the world and all that is. This is the everlasting dominion of which Daniel speaks.

Today, therefore, we give thanks that Jesus has been revealed to us, that we need not fight a futile battle against the universe. Jesus is King. Let us rejoice.


