THE SOLEMNITY OF OUR LORD

*Jesus Christ,  
King of the Universe*



### Hallowed Be Thy Name

Today we come to the end of the liturgical year with the Solemnity of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, commonly called “Christ the King”.

Spiritually, this is a good time for us to take an inventory of the graces God has sent our way this year. Where has the food for our journey come from this past year? In what ways do I find myself being drawn closer to God? There are riches here for each of us and perhaps quite a few that we will share over time.

Our next big step is into the Advent season when we prepare for the dual comings of Christ. We return to the crib for the birth of Emmanuel, God-with-us, and we straighten our pathways to be ready for

the second coming of Christ when our pilgrimage will reach its fulfilment.

These two realities are where our human preparations also find their home. Some of us will be preparing to visit family or to be visited by family or friends. And if we are not preparing for those things maybe we should still prepare to make the arrival of Christmas a time of beauty and of hope. If this is a difficult time of year then we need to walk gently and to realize how Jesus is the physician who can heal us in ways that we do not expect. One way to think about this is to reflect on how our wounds can be a source of healing for others. Our own perseverance can be real food to help others cope and build hope.

God’s providing love will sneak up on us too. God wants us to taste of that divine love now.

In the Gospels, Jesus often cites His closeness to those who suffer. The first shall be last and the last first. But we are not called only to wait for the completion of salvation by Christ. We are called to share in this saving work. As we approach Christmas let us provide little Epiphanies of the love of God-with-us as we meet one another.
