26th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's Gospel acclamation verse puts the meaning of this Sunday's readings succinctly. Christian life is about maintaining an intimate and trusting relationship with the Good Shepherd. Such a bond shapes hearts, determines actions, and reveals our shortcomings in such a way that we can regard them as failures and yet turn to, and rely on, God's mercy.

Ezekiel's words are meant to inspire rather than threaten, promising that God has a single, dependable criterion for judgment applicable to, and within the power of each individual: righteousness. God takes no pleasure in the destruction of anyone but desires and offers life to each one.

A testimony to this truth can be found in Jesus Christ who, in his selfless act of sharing our human existence, His forgiveness of sinners and His acceptance of crucifixion, showed the extent of God's steadfast love. He liberated people from what bound them, restored them to community and called them to life. If we know *this* Shepherd, then we can willingly respond in obedient faith. Even when we fall short, though, we are not left without a remedy before God. The unrighteous tax collectors and prostitutes gained the kingdom through sincere repentance. We, too, growing in the kind of humble and open attitude towards God and others exemplified by Jesus, can also share the mind of Christ and his final victory.

CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

Level 1: Foundations Course Children Ages 3 – 6

Part 1: Saturday, October 21st, 2017, 9am-4pm; Saturday, April 14th, 2018, 9am-4pm; July 3rd – 6th, 2018, 8:30-4:30ppm Part 2: offered in similar format the following year. Location: St. Basil's Church Hall at the University of St. Michael's College Fee: \$300 inclusive for Parts 1 & 2

This introductory course for adults will explore the foundations of an internationally recognized, Montessori-based approach to the religious education of children known as the *Catechesis of the Good Shepherd* (CGS). The *Catechesis of the Good Shepherd* offers to the youngest children, the most essential aspects of our faith, knowing that these truths will nurture their need to love and be loved and their capacity to enjoy God's presence in their life.

The approximately 90-hour course, offered over the course of two intensive weeks, introduces the biblical and liturgical themes which we present to children, through a combination of conversation, reflection and presentation, delivered as we would share them with children. It is especially designed for those who are interested or already involved in caring for the spiritual lives of children; in the home, parish or school.

HUMANITARIAN RELIEF – MEXICO, CARIBBEAN
