
### **A Message from the Paster**

#### **Spiritual and Human Formation**

This year we have been reading the Gospel according to St. Matthew ("Year A" in the Lectionary). Woven throughout St. Matthew's account is a whole schooling in the life of the followers of Jesus. Jesus' disciples go through many steps along the way. With them, we hear the parables and receive the witness of the miracles. Occasionally, we get glimpses of their very human traits. Peter can be blustery and he so obviously wears his heart on his sleeve. Matthew is very restrained about revealing himself, but we do get a very dramatic description of his conversion. James and John, the sons of Zebedee, whose mother is ambitious for them, are eventually next to Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane.

Spiritual formation helps to effect an interior change, in our behaviour, that is progressively reflected on the outside, in the choices we make and most of all in the very character of the love that we share.

Human formation has similarities. We learn in different ways. Sometimes it is the clarity of an idea. At other times, it is the physical sensation of weaving together a symphony of inputs that result in an elegant basket, or goal, that solidifies what we have learned. There are a myriad of self-help apps and books that nudge us in the direction of some personal goals that we have set.



St. John Paul II often wrote of the truth that we are called to be integral, that is, the whole of our being is called to harmonize with the new life we have been given.

God does love the whole of us. To allow ourselves to be formed more and more according to this integral identity is a beautiful thing.

We become more ourselves. It is our real self that is destined to inherit the Kingdom. So, formation, human and spiritual in the Catholic tradition is not a mechanical indoctrination, but a subtle

and lifelong relationship with God, and others, that supports us in saying, "Yes", to God. From our bones to our heart, from the depths of our soul to the ends of our fingertips we are joined by grace.

This is why it is so important that we look for and find sources for that deep formation that will lead us to let ourselves fall into intimacy with God.
