~ SPECIAL MASSES ~

All Saints Day <u>Wednesday November 1, 2017</u> 12 Noon & 5:30pm

This feast honours all the saints of the Church, known and unknown. The occasion provides an opportunity to reflect on the nature of sainthood and to celebrate the exemplary faithfulness of holy men and women of every place and time whose lives and deeds continue to inspire us. Originally a feast in the Eastern Church for all martyrs, it was extended to the whole Roman Church in the 9th century as a feast including nonmartyrs. It was given this date, November 1, to counter a pagan feast on the same day. In England it was called Allhallows. ('Hallow' is from the Old English word for 'holy') Thus 'Hallowe'en', a vestige of this pagan celebration, is from 'Allhallows even', or 'the eye of All Saints.'

All Souls Day Thursday November 2, 2017 9 am School Mass 12 Noon & 5:30pm


Since the early Church, Christians have prayed for the dead. By the 7th century, some monastic foundations reserved this day to pray for deceased members and benefactors. In 988, Odilo, abbot of the great monastery of Clunny in France, established the tradition of keeping, "with joyous affection, the memory of all the faithful departed who have lived from the beginning of the world until the end." By the 14th century, the commemoration had spread through Europe and was universally accepted in the Latin Church.

Pieta Restored

The bronze Pieta on the front lawn was erected in 1933 as a memorial to Bishop Michael Power and hundreds of St. Paul's Basilica parishioners who died during the typhus epidemic of 1847.

The Pieta has been carefully cleaned using a controlled pressure hose and a conservation—grade detergent. After the Pieta was cleaned, it then went through a process called re-patination to achieve the original intended finish. The Pieta was then waxed and polished. The restoration of the pieta is a gift from a parishioner.


Friends of the Street


