

A Message from the Pastor

Life as a Gift

As I have shared before, my dad went off to war at the age of 27. He was fortunate that he did not see action until June 7, 1944. When he came home, he struggled to find his way. He took a degree at McMaster University in Hamilton and then turned to finding his life's work. Now he was 36 with quite a bit of mileage on him because of the war and the fact that he had done factory work before that from the age of 16. He tried teaching ... and then the seminary for a year ... and after that he started working for a life insurance company. Eventually he switched to general insurance and did a lot more work to be able to write his actuarial exams. He married my mom at age 47.

I was young when he was in his 50's and couldn't understand his gratitude for being able to enjoy the most basic things of life. I was thinking more about what we didn't do or didn't have. I am so grateful now that he was patient and persevered in his vision of what was truly important.



We can sometimes use gratitude to excuse things that do really need to change. On the other hand, we often overlook gratitude and see only the glass half full. One thing is sure, without gratitude, the world and our life become much grittier. We become blinded to the little miracles and revelations of love and beauty that are splattered all over life.

In an age of unprecedented opportunity, our desire for control and our fear of risk seem to expand. But this is a kind of deception. Life can't have a warranty program. To love with the whole of our being and to welcome love with the whole of our being we have to loosen our grip.

Children, grandparents, and those who need us are gifts, each with their own infinite value. In taking into your soul, this Thanksgiving, the gifts so freely shared by God with you may your gratitude allow the beauty, goodness and love you have received and which you give also to multiply a hundredfold.
