Should St. Paul's have a weekday Mass?

We have over the years shared our weekday masses with the Good Shepherd Center at 12 noon. The truth be known the attendance by parishioners is shockingly low. Later masses would, of course, serve more effectively for those who wish to have intentioned masses, but work during the day. We look forward to the written consideration of interested parishioners.


