Thomas the Apostle

This Second Sunday of Easter is called Doubting Thomas Sunday because the Gospel talks about Thomas the apostle, who doubted the resurrection of Jesus when his companions told him about the event.

Throughout his life, he always believed in Jesus, and Jesus was always around him. He lost hope when the source of his inspiration, the light of his life, was nailed to the cross and died. So, when his companions told him that his inspiration had been raised from the dead, he replied: "Unless I see the mark of the nails in His hands and put my finger into the nail marks and I put my hands into His side, I will not believe."

What can we learn from Thomas the apostle?

First, we should not do what he did. Thomas had left the larger group. The other ten, even if they were sad about the death of Jesus, banded together. He detached himself from the group. That is why, when Jesus appeared to the group, Thomas was not able to enjoy Christ's presence. So, when we are sad or are discouraged by our church leaders and other groups, we should not detach ourselves from the Christian community, the Church. The presence of Christ always comes into our Christian community.

Second, Thomas the apostle was sincere. He did not understand what was happening, so he could not grasp fully that a person had died and come back to life. He teaches us a lesson: if we do not understand, then let us humbly, honestly, and sincerely accept the fact that we do not know and understand, so we can ask others to explain it to us.

The third is that we need inspiration to make our lives more meaningful. All of us need inspiration, whether from people or an event, to be strong and continue serving God.

The last is that, after he knew and understood that great event, he went all the way, even unto death, in following Jesus Christ. I hope that when everything becomes clear to us, we can also give ourselves to the Lord in every way.

Our reflection is: Are we doubting God right now? What will we do to solve this problem?


