I am the Resurrection and the Life

Today's Gospel speaks about another sign performed by Jesus in order to increase the faith of His disciples: Jesus brings Lazarus back to life. During Lent, we have heard about Jesus' transfiguration, His encounter with the Samaritan woman and the healing of the blind Bartimaeus. All these events have the same purpose: to testify that Jesus is the true Son of God. Nevertheless, the resurrection of Lazarus is the most extraordinary of these miracles. It reveals that whoever believes in Jesus Christ will have the fullness of life.

Ezekiel's vision in the First Reading describes how God sent His Spirit into the valley of dry bones. Since the people of Israel were like the dead, lacking faith and hope, God promised to open their graves and revive their bodies. He said, "I will put my spirit within you and you shall live." Moreover, St. Paul affirms to the Romans, "anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him." We have been given the Spirit of Christ in Baptism and Confirmation. Now, this life in the Holy Spirit leads us to believe and abide in the Lord even when everything seems to discourage us.

Affected by grieving, Martha and Mary expressed their disappointment with Jesus over the death of their brother. Jesus was his close friend; He was supposed to be there when they called for Him. Yet, when the Lord arrived, Lazarus was in the tomb for four days already. The two sisters were wondering the reason for delay. Isn't He our Saviour? Why has He forsaken us? Despite their doubts, Jesus shows the power of God to whom nothing is impossible.

This Sunday's Liturgy is an invitation to come out of the tomb; to untie the bonds that enslave and separate us. Let us renounce every power that prevents us from enjoying the freedom of God's children. Let us allow simple daily miracles to increase our faith that Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life. God wants us to leave grief behind and find in His Son the fullness of life.
