#### Touching Jesus' Sacred Wounds

After His Resurrection, Jesus appeared to the apostles who hid themselves in the house for fear of persecution. The Risen Lord, though, brings them hope and peace. While the doors were closed, He entered the room, stood before them and greeted them saying: "Peace be with you!" Just as in Genesis God breathed into Adam the breath of life, now Jesus breathes into them the Holy Spirit and gives them the power of forgiving and retaining sin. It is the new creation established by the Lord who is merciful and restores our broken being to grant us fullness of life.

Today's Gospel tells us that Thomas missed this very important moment in the life of the apostles. His suspicion is a result not only of lack of faith but especially of his absence from the community. Where was he when he should be gathered with his brothers? Whenever we distance ourselves from the community of the witnesses of the Risen Lord and become isolated, we are left to stumble and doubt that Jesus is with us. Sometimes we behave like Thomas: "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my hand into his side, I will not believe." We want to see to believe!

By allowing Thomas to touch the wounds of His Crucifixion, Jesus touched Thomas' wound of unbelief. Jesus' wounds are healed and no longer cause harm. They are now "Sacred Wounds" through which we have been healed, said the prophet Isaiah. This encounter between Thomas and Jesus leads to a powerful transformation. Thomas professes: "My Lord and my God." Today, as we approach the Eucharist and are able to touch the Risen Lord, let us ask Him to dispel our doubts, heal our wounds and increase our faith. Fr. 
