

John the Baptizer, who appears in today's gospel, gives us a clue to the secret of human greatness. To be genuinely loved by others, to receive the affection and appreciation that we all crave, we simply must forget ourselves and dedicate our lives to some thing or someone that transcends our selfish interests and human pride. We have to give ourselves over to something that is superior. All of the really great people we've known, if we think about them, are people who have been astonishingly careless about their own importance. In fact they really don't even know that they are important. They lose themselves and forget themselves into what is, for them, supremely important... Really great people are often surprised when people pay them tribute.

John the Baptist was a great man. Jesus Christ said of him: "Of all of the men born of women, none was greater than John the Baptist." And what did John the Baptist say about Jesus? "I must decrease, He must increase." In other words, John the Baptist's awareness was centered on the presence of God in our midst. Ordinary eyes couldn't perceive the Presence of God in the midst of our humanity, but John the Baptist's eyes could. (Fr. Charles Irwin).
