

Decision

In this Sunday's Gospel, we read: *"The birth of Jesus the Christ took place in this way."* As we recall, the Gospel continues by relating the decision by Mary and Joseph that resulted in Jesus' birth. This event also brings to mind how the lives of Mary and Joseph are much like our lives today and of the continuing struggle everyone has to carry out God's requests. It also brings to mind how grateful we should all be that Mary and Joseph did agree to the requests made by God.

Consider for a moment some of the difficulties that Mary and Joseph, who were just normal individuals, had to undergo. They had to go to Bethlehem from Nazareth to be enrolled, and it was not easy traveling at that time. When they arrived in Bethlehem, they had no accommodations, yet they were totally obedient to their God and had strong faith to go through this ordeal. After the birth of Jesus, their problems did not end. Now, with a newborn child, they were told to go to Egypt, a foreign country, Mary and Joseph encountered problems that required them to make difficult decisions.

The birth of Jesus would not have happened if these two individuals had said: "No, I don't have the time. I want to live the easy life and avoid any difficult situations that might result in my losing the friendship of those with whom I'd like to associate. No, I'll just go along with the crowd." Mary and Joseph had to reorganize their whole lives, but it was worth the effort. In our lives, we have to make decisions too like to remain faithful, to honour our parents, to avoid drugs and to associate with those who share their belief in this birth of the Son of God, to love our families, to spend time each day praying the rosary, attending Mass, and supporting the organizations in our parish, and so on.

So, our reflection is: what kind of decision will we do to make our faith in Jesus stronger and for it to bear much fruit in the midst of secular and hedonist society?
