Cardinal Collins has designated seven churches in the Archdiocese of Toronto as Jubilee Churches (St. Theresa's Parish, at Kingston and Midland, is the closest), each with a Holy Door of Mercy. Going through the Holy Door is a spiritual journey which requires the person to receive the

sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist while reflecting on God's great gift of mercy, making a profession of faith and praying for the Holy Father and his intentions. The indulgence may also be obtained when one performs a spiritual or corporal work of mercy. Pope Francis has decreed that the elderly, confined or ill may obtain the indulgence by "living with faith and joyful hope this moment of trial" and receiving the Eucharist or by attending Mass (even through the various means of communication, including television).
