Clay in the Potter's Hands

As we begin the Advent Season the readings of this Sunday exhort us to keep alert for the coming of the Lord. He is like a master who went on a journey and will come back at an unexpected hour. All his servants must be awake when he comes. In his letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul affirms that we lack no spiritual gift necessary for this time of expectation. The Lord prepares us through the Holy Spirit who strengthens our hope and renews our faith.

In the First Reading the prophet Isaiah cries out to God, "tear open the heavens and come down". God's people are experiencing a time of desolation. They believe that God has hidden His face from them as they went astray and sinned against the Lord. Despite their sorrow they did not lose their faith in God's love. Showing their deep confidence they proclaim, "O Lord, you are our Father; we are the clay, and you are our potter; we are all the work of your hand."

Advent is a time of preparation for a new beginning. Once again, the Lord will come to save us with His justice. We recognize our need of change and God does not ignore our repented hearts. He wants to recreate us just as clay in the hands of a potter. Made into new vessels, we are called to leave behind our self-sufficiency as we surrender to God and become channels of His love.


