Feast of the Holy Family

The Sunday after Christmas is Holy Family Sunday. On this day we look at Jesus, Mary and Joseph as a family. They are human in every way that we are human; that is, they were faced with the same challenges all families face. The Gospel of today describes Mary and Joseph doing what all Hebrew parents did for their children. The comments made by Simeon and Anna leave them wondering, as any parents would, what kind of future may be in store for their child. Jesus is presented in the temple as every firstborn is. They share a commonality with all of us and at the same time some of the comments made set Jesus apart. This child both God and human, belongs to both the spiritual and the earthly world.

All of the Readings present us with people of faith. Abraham and Sarah are our ancestors in faith, showing us the wisdom of believing in God's promises. The letter to the Hebrew's (2nd Reading) celebrates the faith of both Abraham and Sarah and underlines the importance of faith. Simeon and Anna (Gospel) are both people of faith who live to see God's promises being fulfilled.

We belong to a family of faith that has existed long before our birth and we are privileged to have received an inheritance of faith which keeps us in communion with God whose love and faithfulness lasts forever.
