Repentance



On this second Sunday of Advent, St. John the Baptist says: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near." The words "repent," "repentance," and "repented", are mentioned over a hundred times in the

Bible. There is a lot of misunderstanding and confusion over what the word repentance means. It refers to a truly God-given, Spirit-led change of heart and mind towards God, and away from sin. The Greek word for repent is metanoia. Metanoia is a biblical term for repentance and a complete change of heart. This change turns one away from sin to serve the living God and live a different life from the one before. We repent when we genuinely believe that we are in the wrong, because we have disobeyed God who is always right. Repenting is turning away from, repenting is change and repenting is living differently. And during the season of Advent we are told to prepare ourselves for Christ's coming at Christmas by a renewal of our lives.

There are three important things about repentance: the first is Conviction, where we admit that we have sinned. During repentance, we not only see ourselves as sinners, but we recognize the fact that we have sinned against a righteous and holy God. The second is Contrition, where we show a hatred for sin. To hate sin is to love God. In true repentance, there is not only the desire to escape the consequences of sin, but to be rid of sin itself because it is displeasing to God. The third is Conversion, where sin is abandoned. Repentance involves the forsaking of sin. It should be stressed that it is not enough just to turn away from sin; we must also turn to God for salvation.

Our reflection is: what does true repentance mean for us? What should we do to change our ways during this advent season?


