#### **First Sunday of Lent**

When Jesus heads out to the wilderness, he is accompanied by the Holy Spirit, the source and author of mission. Here, Jesus is challenged to make choices about his identity and how he would live his mission.

Each test the devil poses begins, "If you are the Son of God." Citing scripture, Jesus responds, "It is written." Jesus is tested to see if he is totally committed to God's mission for him; tested to believe that he can serve God without suffering; tested about his attitude toward power and wealth. In summary, Jesus claims the primacy of God and of God's reign.

The first reading from Deuteronomy reveals the liberating love of God in history, while Saint Paul reminds us that, for us as disciples, "the word of faith that we proclaim" comes from the heart of God and must find a home in our hearts.

From my time in Peru, I can still hear the reflections of the native theologian Gustavo Gutierrez, who would remind us that we go to the word of God to read it and it reads us; we go to it with our questions and it in turn questions us; we go to it as the revealed word of God and it reveals us to ourselves. Such is the power of the Word of God. May God's Word and God's Spirit renew our discipleship during Lent.

The Eucharistic Prayer Part II

The Eucharistic meal is a sacrificial meal, a meal that is both sacred and sanctifying. In his words over the bread and wine of the Last Supper, which we recall during the Eucharistic prayer, Christ eternally bound the Christian Eucharistic meal to his sacrificial outpouring of his life for the life of the world. In the celebration of the Eucharist, Christ unites our sacrifice on the cross. At the same time we proclaim and celebrate the eternal covenant that God established in the Blood of Christ himself. "Lord, look upon this sacrifice which you have given to your Church: and by your Holy Spirit, gather all who share this one bread and cup into the one body of Christ, a living sacrifice of praise.
