

### **Look Deeper at the Commandments**

In this Sunday's Gospel, we heard Jesus giving a teaching and He begins with "You have learnt how it was said to our ancestors." He touches on a few of the Commandments: "Do not kill; do not commit adultery." But with each of those Commandments, He gives a deeper aspect to it and presents an enlightening teaching to help us understand the virtues that flow from the Commandments.

For example, with the Commandment of committing adultery, He says that: "everyone who looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart." As for killing, Jesus says this: "anyone who is angry with their brother or sister will be liable to the council."

The virtue is to go deep. That is the message of Jesus this Sunday. It means that we have to focus not on the Commandments, but on the Word of Life. Nothing is as great as spiritual integrity: not even the eye or the hand. We find the true way of religion in following the words, the way and the heart of Jesus.

Firstly, it is the way of mercy and compassion. The place where compassion 'lives' is in the deepest part of ourselves. The life and love of Jesus for His people will deepen the compassion in our hearts. This essence of religion is deepened with prayer and with listening to others. Then virtue goes deeper than rules and the way of living the Christian life makes sense.

Therefore, we cannot read and take literally the Commandments; instead we have to look deeper at them. There is a challenge to unite the love of God and the love of others in our heart.

Maybe this week we might notice the calls in our ordinary relationships to think compassionately and show compassion. This is the centre and ground of our Christian faith; it is the centre of the life of Christ.

So, our reflection is: do we take Jesus' words seriously? Do we strive to live as He calls us to live?




