The Lord who won His enemy will teach us how to be faithful until the end. With Him, we will not be diverted from our way. During this holy season of Lent may the Holy Spirit lead us from death to life.




A Prayer and Life Workshop is a series of sessions that helps you learn and deepen the art of prayer through
