God is in Control

Every day we need to remember that God is in control of our lives. The readings of today's liturgy assure us of His constant care for His children who are sometimes too worried about their future. The truth is that even though we prudently prepare ourselves for expected and unexpected events, our lives are in God's hands and His designs will always prevail. There is no need of anxiety or fear. Rather, we are encouraged to place our hope in God who never forgets us.

Jesus teaches His disciples to trust in God only. "No one can serve two masters: God and wealth." And He continues, "Seek the Kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." This exhortation comes in opposition to the behaviour of the society in Jesus' time. The powerful would use money as means of manipulating the poor. They were even supported by a religion that considered them pure in spite of the others.

Naturally, Jesus does not approve this kind of belief and practice. He reminds His disciples that God clothes the lilies in the field better than King Solomon could clothe himself. Likewise, God will provide for us from His immense generosity all we need to live with dignity. His love can be compared to a motherly love. So why worry? Do not be overwhelmed by preoccupations. Just embrace God's will through your faith and good works, and leave the rest to Him to whom everything belongs: past, present and future.


