

To Let Go

In the Gospel for this Sunday, John the Baptist gave testimony about Jesus. He said: "Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world." And we know that before Jesus came onto the scene, John the Baptist had the people in his hand. He preached about repentance, baptized people and the people even thought that he was the Saviour. When John the Baptist saw Jesus coming towards him, he had to make a decision. He could look away and hold on to the limelight and the attention that he was getting from the people. But he made the choice to let go and be freed from the clutches of pride and ego. It was in letting go that he was able to point out the Lamb of God.

I think, therein lies his greatness. He was humble enough to let go and make way for Jesus when He appeared. There is one statement from John the Baptist that expressed his understanding of the whole matter. He said: "A man can lay claim only to what is given to him from above." (John 3:27)

Indeed, we can only have what is given to us from above. As for the rest, we will have to let go. It is only in letting go that we can be freed from the trap of the clutches of our own hand.

John the Baptist said that Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. And then, what is this sin that he is talking about? Certainly, when it comes to sin in its broadest understanding, it is what separates us from God. And when we look at how John the Baptist was able to let go of himself and point out Jesus as the Lamb of God, then we can see that particular strand of sin as self-obsession.

John the Baptist showed us how to let go so as to point out Jesus to others. So, can we also do this? Why? What is really the purpose of lives for us?


