Wedding at Cana

Our Gospel for this Sunday, tells us about the story of a wedding in Cana. Maybe some of us think we know this story – we have all heard it many times. It is so well told by John with its powerful image of gallons of the best wine in giant jars that it is firmly planted in our memory. But do we see it as a *'sign'*?

In the story we can see that Mary, Jesus' mother, takes on an important role. Maybe our reflection is: how influential is our mother to us? And do we always listen to our mother whenever she speaks to us?

The backdrop of Jesus' first miracle is the wedding at Cana when there is a shortage of wine. The wedding feast could have already been over earlier than anticipated, but Mary was there to save the day. She went to Jesus because she knew that she exercised influence over her Son. Mary also knew that she had the listening ear of Jesus.

So, what does Mary teach us? She teaches us that we always need to go to Jesus when we have issues in our life. We need to let Jesus take over the driver's seat not the other way around. We need to be patient and undemanding with Jesus.

This simply means that we have to let Jesus answer our prayers in His own time and terms. Not that we are dictating the time and terms of our prayers. Mary is also silently teaching us about humility, patience and acceptance of the will of God in our life.

I hope this Gospel brings us to a deeper reflection about our relationship with Jesus.
