

Participating in the Ministry of Jesus

In today's Gospel, we heard about the beginnings of the ministry of Jesus. He heard that John the Baptist had been arrested and He went back to Galilee and settled in the lakeside town of Capernaum. As He walked by the Sea of Galilee, He called His first disciples: *Peter and Andrew, and James and John*, and all four of them were fishermen.

That sounds like a joke. What kind of strategy was that? If the mission was going to be anything serious and successful, then Jesus would need professionals and not amateurs. More so when it was about the proclamation of the Good News of the Kingdom and curing all kinds of diseases and sickness among the people, Jesus would need the media and communications people, as well as doctors and health care specialists on board. But fishermen? Is there something that we have missed?

The Gospel quoted a prophecy from Isaiah: "the people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, and for those who sat in the region and shadow of death light has dawned." Yes, it was a great light, so great that it didn't look normal; it looked strange and absurd. But for those that it beckoned and called, the light shines and reveals.

So, it was for Peter and Andrew, for James and John, and for you and me, and for all those who follow the light that shines in a strange and absurd world.

Indeed, Jesus is hard to understand. To some, He is strange and absurd. To others, He is a light that is too bright to look at. To us, He calls and beckons us to follow Him and His light will guide us through this strange and absurd world. We may look like "crack-pots" to follow Jesus. But only when there is a crack can the light shine in.

Our reflection is: in what kind of way can we participate in the ministry of Jesus nowadays?


