## Climb the Mountain and Listen to the Lord

"Jesus went up to the mountain and, after He sat down, his disciples came to him." This line in today's Gospel brings a new understanding of the relationship between God and His people. In the Old Testament, Moses was the only one allowed to climb Mount Sinai and talk to God. The people of Israel were to wait for him to come back and reveal to them the word of God. Now Jesus goes up the mountain and His disciples follow Him. He brings the Father closer to all who open their hearts to listen to Him.

As a true teacher, Jesus sits down to instruct His disciples in the ways of faith. The Sermon on the Mountain begins with eight beatitudes. Jesus calls blessed those who are poor in spirit, meek, merciful, pure in heart, peacemakers... those who mourn, hunger and thirst and are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven. Jesus knew that many people were tired of the oppression imposed by the powerful. Even their leaders, religious and political, who were supposed to protect the people, had been seduced by greed and corruption. But God is on their side!

God is the Lord of the poor! He chose them to be recipients of His Kingdom of Justice. Zephaniah, in the First Reading said, "They shall seek refuge in the name of the Lord – the remnant of Israel." As we gather to celebrate God's righteousness, we ask Him to open our eyes, ears and hearts against the injustice of the world; to inspire our words and actions that may bring true peace and wellbeing for all.

In January 2007 the Ark of the Covenant was at our parish in preparation for the 2008 Eucharistic Congress in Quebec (ten years ago!).




