

The Beatitudes

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus is talking about the popular heavenly constitution, the Beatitudes. The meaning of the word "Blessed", as Jesus intends, is happiness. All that Jesus wants for us is to be happy; not according to the world's understanding of what happiness is all about, but according to what God means by this word. The 'happy' that we hear about in this Sunday's Gospel has a different tone and sounds contradictory to what society normally considers a source of happiness.

What is the significance of Jesus' beatitudes and why are they so central to his teaching? The beatitudes respond to the natural desire for happiness that God has placed in every heart.

The Beatitudes are the golden rules for happiness. The blessed may be poor in riches but they find their happiness by putting their trust in a caring God. The blessed may also happen to be materially rich, but because they are poor in spirit, their love for God outweighs their attachment to their wealth and therefore, they are happy. People who are poor in spirit are those: who trust in God (vs. greed); those who are humble (vs. pride); those who forgive (vs. revenge); those who are just (vs. unfairness); those who are merciful (vs. rash judgment); those who are pure of heart (vs. lust) and those who are active witnesses (vs. sloth). These should be our Christian attitudes if we want to be called blessed by God.

Therefore, our reflection is: How do we live out the Beatitudes in our lives in the midst of a secular and materialistic society? What kinds of happiness are we looking for right now?


