Epiphany of the Lord

This is an encounter replete with symbolism and meaning. What stands out is the fact that these wise men discovered the birth of the king by interpreting the signs they had observed. Not limited by presuppositions, false expectations or jealousy, they could see the truth and accept it, where others could not.

Let us pray with grateful hearts for the wisdom to see Christ revealed in the world around us, even when that revelation challenges our preconceptions and invites us to find him where we least expect him. *Rev. Len Altilia, SJ, Winnipeg, MB*
