The Holy Trinity is United Through Love

Today we gather to celebrate the great mystery of the Most Holy Trinity, one God revealed in three different persons: the Father our Creator, the Son our Redeemer and the Holy Spirit our Sanctifier. Indeed, they are perfectly united through the power of love. The Holy Trinity shows us that God is not a solitary being; Father, Son and Holy Spirit are in a constant relationship and the three together make the perfect community; a sign and icon for our earthly communities that strive to become One Body in Christ.

It is like when we light three candles and bring them together uniting their flames. The three flames become one fire with a stronger light and warmth so that you cannot distinguish each one anymore. God is one fire of love and this same love is found equally in all three persons of the Holy Trinity. Therefore, love is the fire that forges and merges the three divine persons as it does in our Church to create unity among us.

Jesus said to Nicodemus that it was actually out of love that God sent His Son into the world, that the world would not be condemned but saved through Him. It is out of mercy and love that God accepted Moses' plea for pardon over the people of Israel, and once again God gave him the tablets of the Law. It is out of love and with faith that, through Baptism, we welcome within us the heavenly presence of the Holy Trinity and become God's dwelling place. We are God's living temple and the One-threefold God teaches us how to live in unity.
