

Continued from last week...

Sir Thomas More refused to speak out against the king, but by not accepting the Act of Supremacy that declared Henry to be the supreme head of the Church of England, he showed himself to be in opposition. He was arrested and imprisoned in the Tower of London. All of his property was taken from his family who became very poor. Everything possible was done to try to convince More to give in to the king. But Sir Thomas More knew that no secular power had jurisdiction over man's soul or the Church's faith. At his trial he spoke well, but was condemned to death. He died asking for prayers for himself and for the king, saying that he died the king's good servant, but God's servant first. He was beheaded in 1535 and was canonized in 1935.

The example of St. Thomas More, martyr, is important, especially in this day and age. He serves as a model of charity, courage and fidelity for all of us.
