

The Smith family came for counselling to deal with the sudden death of their parent. The

children's grief was complicated by the fact that they were now residing with their other parent, with whom they had not spent a great deal of time, due to long work hours to provide for the family. As this grief stricken family learned about each other, how to relate, how to trust, how to love and build a new definition of "family", they began to open up to their counsellor and share what their life was like before their parent's tragic death. One child in the family shared that a trusted adult in their family used to be very abusive to them - physically assaulting them, locking them in closets, and making them hurt each other - to name just a few of the milder incidents. That disclosure to the family therapist led to the arrest of that individual and it also resulted in those children no longer feeling afraid of any future victimization. Close family intimacy, safety, and a brighter future resulted for the Smith family. Last year, ShareLife-supported Family Services agencies provided family counselling to over 5,100 people in the Greater Toronto Area.

Town Hall Meeting Summary

The Finance Council, co-chaired by the pastor and a lay member of the Parish, works with the Maintenance Committee to maintain the building integrity and appearance of the church property. The meeting was held to review and discuss future capital projects, seek support from and inform parishioners of the need to request a short term loan from the Archdiocese to avoid delaying future projects. The sloping roof re-shingling project included correction of a design flaw and rebuilding a portion of the roof found to be structurally unsound. That plus the related emergency flat roof project consumed all available Building Fund money.

We plan to continue with the following structural projects: garage footing, roof and pad work; church stone facing work: church hall brick work. Other improvements under investigation include: LED lighting to reduce energy costs; church cooling using ductless air conditioners; washroom refurbishment; security system upgrade; waste bins relocation to behind garage.

To avoid delaying improvement work, the parish requires a short term loan from the Archdiocese. The loan will be repaid by a combination of Building Fund donations and the Parish portion of the Archdiocese Family of Faith Campaign. More information will be provided regarding this Campaign.

Many good questions were raised and discussed during the meeting; no concerns were identified regarding project selection or funding. We plan to keep the parishioners informed of the project status. Fr. Will Rapozo
