Corpus Christi

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On Holy Thursday we remembered that day when Jesus instituted this Blessed Sacrament. Now we dedicate a special adoration to the Eucharist as the centre of our Christian faith and life. It is the memorial of Christ's Life, Death and Resurrection. He chose to consecrate bread and wine at the Last Supper in order to remain permanently in the life of His disciples.

The Eucharist communicates the Lord's love for us: a love so great that it nourishes us with His Body and Blood; a love freely given, always available to everyone who hungers and needs to be regenerated. To live our faith in the Blessed Sacrament is to allow the Lord to nourish us not only with material food and drink but also with bread and wine that do not perish, the Eucharist.

We profess the real presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. We adore Him in all the tabernacles of the world. He is in our midst! On this Feast of Corpus Christi let us celebrate the Holy Mass with renewed faith, love and respect for the Blessed Sacrament. Remember that when we eat the Consecrated Bread and drink from the Blessed Cup we make communion with God and our brothers and sisters. We abide in Him and He in us!
