The feast day of our patron saint, St. Thomas More, is on Wed., Jun.

St. Thomas More was born in London, England in 1478 and died on July 5, 1535. He was a

statesman, author, scholar and humorist. He was gentle and kind, honest and straightforward, sincere and deeply religious. He was known as England's fairest judge and best Chancellor who was loved and respected by the nobles and common people alike. He died because he opposed King Henry VIII's desire to replace the Pope's position as Head of the Church in England. He was martyred for his refusal to compromise on the unity aspect of the Church.


