

## The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ



This Sunday, the Church celebrates the feast of Corpus Christi, the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. The Body and Blood of Christ, or simply called the Eucharist, is the greatest and deepest mystery of the Church. At the same time it is also the most

difficult to comprehend and understand and to believe, because it is the mystery of God's love for us which is certainly beyond our comprehension and understanding.

What happened at the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fish, like we read in this Sunday, happens at every Mass. The bread and wine are blessed and consecrated and it becomes the Body and Blood of Christ. Yet, for those who believe, no explanation is necessary, but for those who do not believe, then no explanation is possible.

As we know that next Friday the Church will be celebrating the feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. So, the feast of Corpus Christi prepares us to encounter the Heart of Christ. Because the Body of Christ that we receive at Holy Communion is nothing less than the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the most profound blessing of God. And that's why in receiving the Body of Christ, which is the Heart of Christ, we must make that act of faith, that is, we must say "Amen."

In doing so, we are also asking Jesus to make our hearts like His, so that our love may be multiplied to feed the hungry of the world. That is the lesson that we must keep learning at every Eucharist.

Our reflection is: what does the Eucharist mean for our lives as Catholics in our daily lives nowadays?


