Ascension of the Lord

Today we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord, but what does it mean for us?

With His Ascension, Jesus returned to the Father in Heaven, but He is still with us through the Holy Spirit. He now commissions us to continue His work; to keep spreading His message of Good News and to keep living and proclaiming His Gospel. We are on the journey towards the fullness of God's Kingdom. Everything we do and say is directed towards cooperating in God's work of the Kingdom.

If Jesus had not returned to the Father, we would still be saying "there he is over there!" or "here he is over here!" But now, by returning to Heaven and sending the Holy Spirit to us, Jesus is "all in all" because He makes His home in our hearts and in our world, through the Holy Spirit. Meanwhile, we work to have Christian values and action in our homes, workplaces and our city.

The Gospel of Luke on the Ascension has a fascinating and different focus from Matthew and Mark's versions. In these other two Gospels, the disciples are sent out on a mission. In Luke, they are implicitly sent on a mission, but they are particularly sent out, in the visible absence of Jesus to be witnesses of Jesus Christ in their words and actions in the world. Our Lord's absence is not as if He is dead and gone. Rather, He is alive, and with the Father, and He will return at the end to complete all things. In the meantime, we must be His hands and eyes and heart in the world, through the Holy Spirit. And the Holy Spirit will help us to make Jesus present in a world which can be too often filled with selfishness, undue privilege, arrogance, and abuse of power and authority. Tragically this world can show a terrible indifference towards the poor, the hungry and the suffering.

Jesus now entrusts His ministry to us, through the presence of His Spirit. The question is: how do we continue His work: to keep spreading Jesus' message of the Good News and to keep living and proclaiming His Gospel in our daily lives?
