In today's Gospel Luke tells us that Jesus is determined to go to Jerusalem. This would be His last trip with His disciples. Before reaching their final destination they need to make a stop and Jesus asks them to go ahead and arrange for their stay in Samaria. At this time, Jesus and His disciples were not welcome in the village. Jesus is about to face His condemnation and people are afraid of being connected to Him and accused of supporting a criminal. Though they did not receive Him, He showed no resentment against them. God does not keep grudges!

Others clung to Jesus and promised to follow Him wherever He might go. To these, Jesus was very honest; His life is modest and unpredictable. He has no possessions and does not offer any material wealth. Those who choose to be His followers must leave everything behind, embrace poverty and announce the Good News with joy and simplicity.

Nevertheless, Jesus says "No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks to what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God." He seems to be too harsh and strict. However, the mission is urgent and the missionaries should not waste time. When Jesus calls us, we cannot be reluctant; we are to respond to our vocation with an undivided heart and no hesitation. Do not look behind, come to Him and He will lead you to true happiness.


