He Suffers With Us

The Gospels repeat in various passages that Jesus had compassion for the suffering. He revealed to us that God our Father is not distant or indifferent. Rather, God has a Heart that loves and cares for His children. He gave us life and chose to be present to everyone through the incarnation of His Son. As God-made-man, Jesus lived a real human life with all its joys and struggles. He was like us in every way but sin. Thus, He showed solidarity with our frailty and sanctified our human condition. He lifted us up with Him; He saved us.

To have compassion means "to suffer with"; Jesus accepted suffering as a share in the suffering of all brothers and sisters who have been abandoned. His special closeness to the poor and marginalized reveals the depths of God's mercy which reaches out to those who have been forgotten. Thus He fulfills the promise; "even if a mother forgets a child, I will not forget you" (Is 49:15).

In today's Gospel Jesus shows compassion for a widow whose son had passed away. Likewise, the First Reading brings another widow who cried out to Elijah. Both of them have become lonely and helpless. They have nobody else to care for them but God. Indeed, God heard their cry and the sense of death, grief, pain and hopelessness were turned into life, joy and hope. This is compassion! God suffers with us; He cares. Even though He seems to be distant sometimes, the compassionate Heart of Jesus is right there to raise us up.


