Pentecost



This Sunday the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Pentecost. John, in his Gospel, tells us that Jesus came to His disciples in the room, with the doors closed for fear of the Jews. Jesus said to them, "Peace be with you," and after saying that Jesus breathed on them and

said, "Receive the Holy Spirit."

This action of breathing on the disciples brings us back to the book of Genesis 2:7, where in the creation of man, God formed man from the dust of the earth and then He breathed into the nostrils of the man and the man became alive. So, the breath of God is the breath of life, the gift of the Holy Spirit, who is the Lord and Giver of life who proceeds from the Father and the Son, as we profess in the Creed.

Jesus breathed into His disciples the breath of new life, a breath of forgiveness, a breath of healing, a breath of love, the breath of the Holy Spirit. And we can see the effects of the Holy Spirit in the disciples: they went forth to proclaim the Good News and brought a lot of people to be followers of Jesus. The same Holy Spirit has breathed into all of us too.

Our reflection is: "What does the Holy Spirit wants us to do? Where is He leading us to?"

It is important to reflect on these questions especially, now that our world has become so complex and many of us seem confused. We should pay attention and be docile towards Him. We should let Him lead and show us the best way to be faithful followers, so that we can bring many people to God and to proclaim the Good News of the marvels of God. Let us walk with the Holy Spirit, our Counselor and Advocate.


