#### **Corpus Christi**

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On Holy Thursday we remembered the day when Jesus instituted this Blessed Sacrament and now we commemorate the Eucharist as the centre of our Christian faith and life. It is the memorial of Christ's life, death and resurrection. He chose to consecrate bread and wine at the Last Supper in order to remain permanently present in the life of His disciples.

The Eucharist communicates the Lord's love for us: a love so great that it nourishes us with Himself; a love freely given, always available to every person who hungers and needs to regenerate his own strength. To live the experience of faith means to allow oneself to be nourished by the Lord and to build one's own life not with material goods but with the reality that does not perish: the gifts of God, His Word and His Body.

We profess the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. He is in our midst! For this reason, every Mass should be celebrated with faith, love, respect and profound devotion. Remember that when we eat the blessed bread and drink from the blessed cup we establish a strong communion with God and our neighbour. We abide in Him and He in us!
