Forgiveness



In our experience, wrongdoing and shame are not easily forgotten, neither in life nor in death. And that was the issue the Pharisees had in the Gospel for this Sunday. They complained that Jesus welcomed tax collectors and

sinners and ate with them, because for them tax collectors and sinners should not be forgiven. It was in the face of that kind of attitude and that kind of stand-off that Jesus told the famous parable of the Prodigal Son.

We know of some people who can be identified with the younger son who had committed such a deplorable act of insult against his father. We may even think that his sin is unforgivable and that his memory should be erased and not to be mentioned again. But this is where we need to be jolted to a halt and realize that we are just like that older son who does not want to forgive his brother nor forget the wrong he had done.

This parable points out to us that we have the sinfulness of the younger son and yet, at the same time, we too, have the unforgiveness of the older brother. But the overriding important meaning of the parable is the unconditional forgiveness of the Father, which is God Himself. God our Father forgives us our sins because He wants us to be freed from the clutches of our own sins. He doesn't want us to go down to the grave chained by our sins. He wants to remember us and not our sin.

Our reflection is: do we have someone that is waiting for forgiveness from us right now? Why do we have a problem to forgive someone unconditionally the same as we have received from God?
