#### With Jesus in the Desert

Temptations are present in the life of all God's children. While we are in this world there will always be something trying to dissuade us from the truth. Jesus also faced the same situation as He was tempted by the devil in the desert. The tempter appeared to Him as a very astute liar using God's Word to confuse Him. However, the Gospel relates that it was the Holy Spirit who led Jesus to the desert. During forty days of prayer He was in profound communion with the Father and His will. Therefore Jesus responded to the devil with firmness and wisdom. Enlightened by the same Word of God He conquered every temptation.

Today's Gospel summarizes the purpose of the Lenten Season. With a spirit of humbleness we renounce pride, luxury and power to become simple servants of the Lord in our needy brothers and sisters. Thus we reject Satan and bow down to Christ alone for He is the revelation of the true and Merciful God.

The desert can be a place of danger and fear; but it is precisely in times of weakness that we are called to find strength in God. As a desert, the Lenten Season is an invitation to turn back to the Lord for He is our refuge against evil. He is our oasis! Journeying in the wilderness, do not let worldly desires lure you; rather fix your eyes on the Lord who taught us how to win against temptation. Seek reconciliation with God and your brothers and sisters to welcome His love and forgiveness into your heart.

## Food and Clothing Drive




West Hill Food Bank, which is our local food bank, has informed us that they are in desperate need of immediate assistance to replenish their supplies of non-perishable
