#### The Parable of the Merciful Father

On this fourth Sunday of Lent we read about a very familiar passage of the Gospel known as "The Parable of Prodigal Son". It recounts the story of a young man who asked for his father's inheritance, left home and spent all that money in a self-indulgent way. After suffering starvation, he repented and chose to come back as his father's employee. The father's older son, though, became angry as soon as he learned that his brother was back. It seems that this story is focused either on the younger son who asked for pardon, or on the older son who struggled to forgive. However, the core character of this parable is the father. It could be called "The Parable of the Merciful Father".

It is the Merciful Father who remained looking down the road and untiringly waited for the return of his younger son. It is also the Merciful Father who patiently went out to meet the older son when he refused to join the party. God is the Merciful Father! He does not give up on any of His children. He runs to us, kisses and embraces us when we come back. He restores our dignity by giving us a robe, sandals, ring and food. Remember that every time you celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation you are encountering this Merciful Father who forgives and rejoices with you. Today is the Joyful Sunday! Come back to God and allow the Merciful Father to love you. Celebrate with Him the joy of being saved again.


