

Glorifying the Lord Through Our Lenten Exercises

This Sunday's Gospel talks about Jesus'
Transfiguration and was one of the most magnificent
displays of God's glory the world has seen. The purpose
of the Transfiguration was to give His apostles, and all of
us, a deeper understanding of who He is. So, what can we
learn from it?

Clearly, this was a dramatic revelation for Peter, James, and John. They never forgot what happened that day. Decades after it happened, John wrote, "We saw his glory" (John 1:14). Peter said, "We had been eye witnesses of his majesty . . . when that unique declaration came to him from the majestic glory" (2 Peter 1:16, 17). The Transfiguration showed them that the kingdom of God which Jesus had been preaching about would be characterized by glory. But it also encouraged and strengthened them for the ordeal of the cross that lay before them. For as they learned at Calvary, the glory of God comes not only through displays of magnificence, but also through self-giving love: a love that embraces even death.

The Holy Spirit wants us to learn both of these concepts of glory. He wants us to see that Jesus is glorified every time we worship Him at Mass and in prayer, and He is glorified every time we go out of our way to help someone, when we reverence Him during Eucharistic adoration, and every time we confess our sins or forgive someone who has hurt us.

Let these lessons about glory and self-giving love sink into our heart. As we dwell on the glory of Jesus' Transfiguration, see that it is a glory that comes because of His cross. Then, tell Him that we want to be changed into His glorious image. Ask Him to take our every act of love and fill it with His presence. It really is possible for us to live "for the praise of his glory" (Ephesians 1:12).

Our reflection is: How can we use the traditional practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving during Lent to open ourselves to a deeper relationship with Jesus? What steps are we taking to bring glory to God through our Lenten practices? Is there more we can do?




There will be a training session for new altar servers on Sat., Mar. 14 at 10:00 a.m. Children who have received their First Holy Communion are welcome to attend.


